





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## CEHRT FAQs

### CEHRT FAQs

- CEHRT is governed by the ONC and do not require Vendors to be compliant with CMS annual updates.
- CMS releases annual updates to reporting and attestation requirements not required by Vendors ONC certification.
- Even if the CEHRT is compliant, if the reporting versions have changed – clients will not be able to successfully report.
- Reporting for 2018 sites must be on a 2015 CEHRT.
- Changes for 2015 CEHRT are substantial, in order to give sites the ability to report successfully in 2017 and beyond a partnership with **FIGmd** has been established.

## Why FIGmd

### Why FIGmd?

- FIGmd is a leading clinical data solutions and management services Provider.
- FIGmd operates and manages 18 of the largest medical specialty Registry platforms and support over 35,000 providers in the US.
- FIGmd has pioneered the technology behind seamless, automated, data extraction from EHRs and PM systems through its ELIXIR interface solution.
- **ELIXIR** provides a gateway for providers to submit data to multiple reporting Registries, while complying with **MACRA MIPS/APM** requirements.
- FIGmd offers the site to choose and report on any of the CQM measures. (Not just the specific measures in the EHR)
- FIGmd is 2015 Certified.

## What FIGmd is not

### What FIGmd is not:

- **ELIXIR** is not a Health Information Exchange (HIE). However, if your data needs to be augmented from a local HIE that can be considered. ELIXIR's primary purpose is to work with your eMDS HER to extract data and report it to the appropriate Clinical Data Registry.
- **ELIXIR** is not a Registry. It is an interface that qualifies providers for the appropriate specialized Registry based on their NPI and taxonomy numbers.
- **ELIXIR** is not part of a Practice Transformation Network (PTN). The ABFM Prime Registry works with the Practice Transformation Networks and over the next three years, through enrollment in one of twenty-nine Practice Transformation Networks, clinicians will have access to the extensive nationwide, collaborative CMS Quality network, which includes the thirty-nine Practice Transformation and Support and Alignment Networks of the Transforming Clinical Practice Initiative.

### CEHRT update

- Practice Partner, Medisoft Clinical and Lytec MD are currently getting a new CEHRT which excludes CQM certification.
- Reporting for 2017 reporting will be done with a combination of CEHRT numbers that will be available on the **chpl.healthit.gov website**.
- eMDS will be releasing guidance on how to use combination certification numbers.
- **2015 CEHRT** functionality will be released throughout the year. eMDS is committed to communicating the changes to educate you on the functionality and how best to use it.

## Reporting tools within EHR:

- eMDs will not be updating the QRDA creator, and recommends **FIGmd's** ELIXIR as alternative solution for MIPS reporting.
- An updated reporting tool for reporting **Advancing Care Information** will be available in Practice Partner, Medisoft Clinical and Lytec MD.
- **FIGmd** offers the ability to **submit ACI and Improvement activities** into your FIGmd account, and they will submit the attestation directly to CMS for you.

## Signing up for FIGmd

- Registration for a **site** must be done directly between the site and **FIGMD**.
- You must register through **ELIXIR** for 2017 reporting period if you wish to have your data extracted.
- Visit [emds.elixirmd.com](http://emds.elixirmd.com) to get started with registration.

- **Fees collected in the ELIXIR sign-up portal**
- A **Client Account Manager** will assist practices with their Registry enrollments.
- Practices are encouraged to register with ELIXIR as soon as possible.
- Account number will be provided to you by eMDS. This is generally the 10 digit registered phone number of the practice. Although practices are encouraged to confirm this with eMDS.

# Data Collection & Tech Support

- Practices who need support after the registration process can email their inquiries to [support@emds.elxirmd.com](mailto:support@emds.elxirmd.com)
- For eMDS related questions, you may open a support ticket with eMDS through their support services.
- Installation of the ELIXIR connector takes approximately 15-20 minutes. This process requires the ability to get onto the sites network and access to both the EHR and the Practice Management system.
- The ELIXIR connector is set to extract data on a nightly basis. However, it can be configured as per the practice needs.
- When FIGmd does the initial data extract they go back a standard of 12-18 months to pull the data.
- FIGmd can pull unstructured and structured data; however, there are certain types of documents that may not be captured in the initial data extract. In order to reduce data extraction errors, a Client Account Manager will be assigned to the practice to assist with data mapping and refinements.

## Dashboard

- Once the solution is deployed, data pull occurs automatically, in the background. The data pull is scheduled at sites convenience.  
Daily, Weekly, Every other week  
The dashboard will also refresh on a monthly and quarterly basis.
- The dashboard will produce data for providers who have chosen to participate in the program.
- There is an analytics module in the dashboard, that will give you access to all the data that is being collected for the registry. It will give you the ability to do pivot tables and drill downs on the data. This is part of the dashboard.
- The dashboard is access through the web.
- The Registry dashboard can display the data per provider for each measure.
- FIGmd team members review the dashboard with the practice.

# Submissions

- Providers must individually sign their Data Release Consent form (DRCF) prior to data submissions to CMS. After the DRCF has been signed, data will be submitted.
- Registries inform the providers that submission will take place during January 1 – March 31.
- Provider receives an email from CMS advising that their submission has been received, and if it has been accepted.
- CMS submission period is January 1 – March 31.


